| Prerequisites | Students have learned Chinese for more than 2 years in China or 3 years out of China. If you are unsure about your CEFR level before registering, contact the course teacher. <i>Completed KK-KII302 Advanced Chinese 2 or KK-KII303 Advanced Chinese 3, KK-KII305 Advanced spoken Chinese 1 or students have a command of 1500 Chinese words and a certain amount of grammar.</i> |
| Learning outcomes | After completing the course, students are expected to be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Understand a wide range of topics, produce correct sentences, create cohesive discourse, and express themselves fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. 2. Communicate with native speakers, achieving a relatively high level in speaking Chinese; 3. Acquire clear and natural pronunciation and intonation in everyday communication. 4. Have a clear understanding of Chinese culture and know the differences and similarities between Chinese culture and their own. |
| Course completion methods | This is a contact-learning course with 28 hours of contact teaching and 26 hours of independent work. To complete the course at least 75% active participation in the course, taking exams and completion of the home assignments by the deadline is required. |
| Course content | The course topics include wide range of Chinese speaking, such as education, food culture, travelling, movies, love and marriage, environment, commercial pattern, business, studies etc. Learners will gain further insight into language structures, expand their vocabulary, as well as improve their listening comprehension, intonation and speech production. Language use situations: conversation strategies, argumentation, composition of a structured presentation. |
| Study materials | Provided by the teacher. |
| Assessment practices and criteria, grading scale | Based on the aspects mentioned under the course objectives. Continuous evaluation: small review tests, regular and active participation in classroom work, mid-term oral exam, final exam, completion of the home assignments. The course is graded as pass/fail. |
| Connection to other courses | After this course you can take KK-KII403 Advanced Chinese 5 Simultaneously with KK-KII304 Advanced Chinese 4 is recommended. |
