Objective	Through the Chinese painting course, students gain the basic knowledge of Chinese painting, technical skills and artistic styles. Understand also the evolution and development of East Asian art and the philosophical ideas contained therein.
Course content	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction of Chinese painting, which include its historical development, features, basic technique skills, artistic styles and painting tools and material. 2. Study of the general rules and techniques of drawing traditional Chinese painting. 4. Appreciation of classical East Asian painting masterpieces. 5. Introduction of painting formats in East Asian art. 5. Practical practice of copying and creating for flower-bird and landscape painting works.
Course material	<p>Students have possibility to purchase painting tools and materials at Confucius Institute before the start of the course</p> <p>2 painting brushes 17e Ink 250g 8e Painting Carpet 100x50cm 10e Paint package 12 colors 16e Rice paper 138x69cm 1e/piece</p> <p>These can be bought from the teacher. Those who have brushes, carpet etc. from calligraphy course can use those.</p>
Course completion methods	<p>This is a Chinese painting course with 28 hours of online teaching and 26 hours of independent work. In order to get the credits, at least 75% live- online teaching class attendance is required and students need to complete the required homework and write a 4-5 pages long essay.</p> <p>The main platforms are Zoom and Moodle. Before the class, students will receive a zoom link and use this link to enter the zoom meeting. After class students can upload homework and interact with teacher through moodle. Students who cannot use moodle send homework to the teacher's mailbox.</p>
