Venue	Distant Learning mode: First session (60 minutes, on Zoom) Second session (30 minutes, on Moodle)
Target group	Students of all programmes and faculties, students in the flexible study rights scheme (JOO), international students and non-university learners.
Timing	After KK-KII101 Elementary Chinese 3 (2cr).
Prerequisites	Starting level approximately CEFR A1. Having completed KK-KII101 Elementary Chinese 3 or equivalent studies of 74 hours. If you are uncertain about your CEFR level , contact the teacher before signing up.
Learning outcomes	After completing the course, students are expected to be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Understand normal, clear speech and longer texts. 2. Learn about 600 Chinese words. 3. Communicate with people using a variety of vocabulary and key structures, 4. Learn around 400 Chinese characters and its structures, 5. Use the fundamental grammars and structures mentioned below.
Course completion methods	This is a contact learning course with 28 hours of contact teaching and about 53 hours of independent work. To complete the course at least 75% active participation in the course and completion of the agreed tasks by the deadline is required.
Course content	<p>Listening: long normal speed statements and dialogues</p> <p>Reading: short texts</p> <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • complicated comparative sentences • “ba” sentences • adverbs “cai and jiu” • compound complement of direction • flexible use of interrogative pronouns, such as “shenme, nar” • complex complements of state • extension of the complements of direction • “bei” sentence (passive voice)
