

Information to participant

- The interview will be recorded and an anonymized transcript or summary of the interview will be produced.
- You will be sent the transcript or interview summary and given the opportunity to correct any factual errors.
- The transcript or interview summary will be analyzed by a member of the research team.
- Any summary interview content or direct quotations from the interview, that are made available through academic publication or other academic or non-academic outlets will be anonymized so that you cannot be identified. Care will be taken to ensure that other information in the interview that could identify yourself is not revealed. Your name and affiliation will be kept and may be listed in selected publications for reasons of transparency.
- The recorded data and anonymized transcript or interview summary will be kept, but access to the recorded data will be limited to academic colleagues and researchers with whom we might collaborate as part of the research process.
- Any variation of the conditions above will only occur with your further explicit approval.

All or part of the content of your interview may be used

- in academic papers, policy papers, news articles or similar formats,
- in other media that we may produce such as spoken presentations, and
- in an archive of the project as noted above.

By agreeing to participate in this interview, I understand that:

- I am taking part in this project voluntarily. I understand that I do not have to take part, and I can stop the interview at any time without giving a reason.
- The recorded data, transcript or interview summary or extracts from it may be used as described above.
- I have read the privacy note.
- I do not expect to receive any benefit or payment for my participation.
- I can request a copy of the transcript or interview summary and may make edits if I feel necessary to ensure the effectiveness of any agreement made about confidentiality.
- My name and affiliation is kept and may be used as described above.
